## **THE RCMP WARN PUBLIC OF HIGH RISK SEX OFFENDER**

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police, in the interest of public safety, is issuing the following information and warning in regard to the release of a Federal inmate to the Edmonton Provincial Capital District area.

**Bruce Donald WINDSOR** will be released from custody on March 26, 2010, upon completion of his Two year sentence, for Possession of Child Pornography, Accessing Child Pornography, and Sexual Interference. This offender represents a significant risk to sexually offend against young females and poses a considerable risk to the community.



**Bruce WINDSOR** is a 48 year old Caucasian Male, 177CM (5'10) and 80KG (176) with blue eyes and brown hair. Bruce WINDSOR will be residing within the Edmonton Provincial Capital District area. He is bound by a 3 year Probation Order and must abide by a Section 161 CC order which lists several conditions which address community concerns. Specifically they are:

- 1. A 20 year order prohibiting him from attending a public park, public swimming area, daycare center, school ground, playground or community center where children under the age of 14 are present.**
- 2. A lifetime prohibition from obtaining employment, paid or volunteer, that involves being in a position of trust towards a person under age 14.**

- 3. A lifetime prohibition from using a computer system for the purposes of communicating with a person under the age of 14.**

The RCMP are issuing this information and warning after careful deliberation and consideration of all related issues, including privacy concerns, in the belief that it is clearly in the public interest to inform the members of the community of the release of **Bruce WINDSOR**.

Members of the public are advised that the intent of the process is to enable members of the public to take suitable precautionary measures and not to embark on any form of vigilante action. Anyone believing that a crime has been or is about to be committed is encouraged to call police. If the matter is felt to be of an urgent nature please call 911 to report the location circumstances.
