PROGRAMS

Our exciting, engaging programs suit every student's ability, interests and goals!

ALBERTA CURRICULUM

Sturgeon Heights School follows the Alberta Curriculum, which specifies the knowledge and skills that students are expected to learn, set by Alberta Education.

HEADSTART

Headstart is designed for children between the ages of 3½ to 5 who need communication and/or developmental support. Children get a jumpstart on their education, building skills in communication, social development, physical development and emotional development. Screening is required.

ENRICHMENT

The Enrichment program is designed for preschool and kindergarten students who are deemed developmentally advanced. Enrichment focuses on academic enrichment and encourages community involvement, exposing children to music, art, books and second languages. Screening is required.

KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students are packed with passion and potential to be anything they want in the world. We work hand-in-hand with parents, offering half-day programs to prepare each learner for the transition from home to school and entry into Grade 1.

ATHLETICS

We offer cross country running, a running club, volleyball, basketball, badminton and track and field. Students in grades 6 to 9 participate in interschool league play. We also run intramural programs for students in grades 4 to 9 so they can build friendships across grade levels.

ORAL FRENCH PROGRAM

This program provides instruction for beginner conversational French, starting at Grade 4 and continuing in junior high as an option.



LEADERSHIP

This unique program gives students the opportunity to explore their own leadership skills, develop their understanding of leadership locally and on the world stage, and to practice leadership and group skills through organizing and promoting events in and around our school.

MUSICAL THEATRE

Sturgeon Heights School offers Musical Theatre as an extracurricular activity for students in grades 4 to 9. In this creative program, new choreography is created each year for the group to perform at competitive festivals and school and community events.

PROGRAM UNIT FUNDING

PUF provides assistance for students between the ages of 2 ½ and 6 years who have a diagnosed need in one or more areas (speech and language, behaviour and fine or gross motor skills). PUF children are fully included in preschools and kindergarten, as well as supported at home, to help your child reach his/her potential.
